

The earliest township survey resulting in the Kalispell Township plat was filed in April of 1891. Kalispell is located in the upper Flathead Valley of Flathead County, and has served as the county seat since 1893.

Kalispell lies at an elevation of 2,955 feet along the valley floor, with the Cabinet Mountain Range to the west, the Continental Divide to the east, and Flathead Lake (the largest fresh-water lake west of the Mississippi) nine miles to the south. The word "Kalispell" has its origins in the Native American Pend d'Oreille language, meaning "prairie above the lake."
